## **COVID-19 Vaccines** Tell us your thoughts




**We asked** If a COVID-19 vaccine is made available through the NHS, would you consider being vaccinated?

I want to get back to some sort of reality without getting sick, protect the elderly and support NHS approval process


It would depend on the kind of vaccine. I would prefer to wait a few months to become convinced it is worth the risk









## We asked If a COVID-19 vaccine is made available through the NHS, would you consider being vaccinated?







Asian: 697 responses




Mixed: 140 responses



Unspecified: 187 responses






Results breakdown

By ethnicity


Any other white background: 671 responses

Other Ethnicity: 44 responses








If you care for someone vulnerable, or have a loved one in a care setting, would you encourage them to receive a COVID-19 vaccine?
